We at Mareeba Kids Campus believe in maximizing the potential of early childhood and children experience learning that is engaging and builds success for life. Our centre has implemented the Early Years Framework. We are an approved Kindergarten following the Queensland Kindergarten Curriculum.

1. The needs of the child shall be the first and major consideration.
2. All children have the right to experience quality childcare.
3. All children should be treated equally and each child's social and cultural background will be acknowledged and respected
4. Parents/ Caregivers are paramount in the decision making concerning their children.
5. Care and education should enhance the development of the child and support the family.
6. The centre should provide an atmosphere that is warm, accepting and welcoming to both children and adults.
7. Care and education should facilitate the development of self esteem, confidence, independence and interest in learning of all children.
8. Conflict must be resolved peacefully.
9. There should be respect for the Natural environment.
10. Learning must not be limited by gender, race or colour. Our first Australians and Torres Strait Islanders cultures are valued.
11. Promote continuity of childrens personal health and hygiene by sharing ownership of routines with the children, families and community.
12. Educators will regularly observe and assess childrens development stages and needs and plan and evaluate the program accordingly.
13. The program will reflect the diverse values of the community
14. The learning curriculum must recognise the varied individual learning characteristics and needs of each child.
15. Children learn through their play, interests and meaningful interactions with others.

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
